

Independent Study Courses

Independent Study (1 to 4 credits). Involves investigation under faculty supervision beyond what is offered in existing courses. Cannot be repeated more than once. Prerequisites: junior standing and consent of the instructor.

Independent study courses are numbered as 396 or 496 courses. The three-letter course prefix reflects the field of study of the course (e.g., independent study courses in architecture are coded as ARC 396 or ARC 496).

Students are allowed to take one independent study. A second independent study could be approved by the student's associate dean for graduate purposes only.
