

## Special Topics Courses

**Special Topics (1 to 4 credits).** Presents a theoretical or practical topic proposed by the faculty beyond what is offered in existing courses. Can be repeated for credit. Prerequisites: topic specific. Lab/tech fee may apply.

Special topic courses are numbered as 294, 394 or 494 courses. The three-letter course prefix reflects the field of study of the course. Special topics courses at the 300 level require sophomore standing or above; 400-level special topic courses are restricted to junior standing and above. Descriptions of particular special topics courses are made available in the college/school offering the course during registration
