The SEC met on Tuesday February 7<sup>th</sup> for its regular meeting. The main item on the agenda was the proposal of the Senate Committee on Evaluation and Standards of Performance regarding Faculty Awards Guidelines. The SEC members went through the proposal and made some amendments. They finally voted to bring the guidelines as amended to the Senate floor. We will vote on it today.

I would like to announce that two grievance cases were filed by two SBM faculty. The Senate Executive Subcommittee responsible for these Grievances has already launched a Senate Grievance Committee for one case and is studying the second case.

I would like also to announce that VC Mosbo replied positively to the Senate President's request to review AUS research policy before it gets published. A Senate ad-hoc committee is studying the policy. Its report will come to the SEC then to the Senate floor.

I would like finally to announce that next Tuesday is the elections for the Senate Executive Committee of the 2006-2007 AUS Faculty Senate.
