

Transportation Service to Abu Dhabi and Al Ain

All trips to Abu Dhabi and Al Ain are non-stop.

Buses to AUS to Abu Dhabi on Wednesdays as follows:

From Women's Dorms at 3:30 and 8:30pm during Ramadan and at 3:30 and 6:30pm after Ramadan.

From Men's Dorms East at 3:40 and 8:40pm during Ramadan and at 3:40 and 6:40pm after Ramadan.

Buses to AUS to Al Ain on Wednesdays as follows:

From Women's Dorms at 4:40pm during Ramadan and at 5:15pm after Ramadan.

From Men's Dorms East at 4:40pm during Ramadan and at 5:25pm after Ramadan.

From Abu Dhabi and Al Ain to AUS on Saturdays as follows:

From Abu Dhabi and Al Ain on Saturdays at 9:00pm during Ramadan and after Ramadan at 5:30pm.

Students travelling to Abu Dhabi will be dropped off and subsequently picked up at the Corniche, in Khalidiya, across the street from the All Prints Library.

Students travelling to Al Ain will be dropped off and subsequently picked up at the Parking of Al Khaleej Hospital.

About the Bus Pass

Passes to and from Abu Dhabi and Al Ain are available for four (4) weekend roundtrips at a cost of AED 300. Semester passes are also available at a cost of AED 600. Each pass is stamped and dated accordingly.

To receive a bus pass, students must register online through their Banner account. Upon registering on Banner, students need collect their bus pass from the Transportation Division's office at the beginning of each semester - from registration day onwards - between the hours of 9:00 am to 1:00 pm Sunday to Wednesday.

Once a student has registered online, the purchase will automatically be charged to his or her student account. There are **no cancelations or refunds** once a student has registered for a pass. If a student loses his or her pass, he or she will have to buy a new pass; the university will not issue replacement passes. The university requires a minimum of 10 registered students to feasibly operate any bus route; should that requirement not be met, the bus service for the respective route may be withdrawn.

Reservations

Prior to travelling, students must book their seats in advance for each individual weekend roundtrip through their Banner account. Upon booking, the trip will be deducted from the student's pass. If a student decides not to travel after booking the trip, the student can cancel the trip through the Banner before trip bookings close. Thereafter, once a student has confirmed a trip there will be **no cancelations or refunds**. Trip bookings close on Thursday at 10:00am prior to the weekend of travel. Students who show up without prior booking of their trip may be turned back due to unavailability of space. Students are required to present their bus pass before boarding the bus.

Baggage Allowance

Students are allowed to carry on one small bag (approximate dimensions 20"x15"x10"), with a clearly labeled address tag on it. Students must place their bag in the luggage compartment of their respective bus. Reserving seats for friends is strictly prohibited. Students are asked to refrain from yelling or playing loud music throughout the trip. Students must not interfere, distract or abuse the bus driver in anyway. Repeated violators of the above rules will have their bus passes revoked.
