Why should I study abroad?

When you travel, you can have the adventure of a lifetime. By studying abroad, you can:

What are the requirements?

The basic requirements to study abroad are:

- good standing
- minimum of 60 credits completed at AUS
- minimum GPA of 2.75
- cannot take senior design project while abroad

Other requirements apply based on your specific program. Check with IXO for details.

What are my options?

Our study abroad program allows a student to leave AUS to study at another university for up to two semesters while earning AUS credit. We offer many options for our students to study abroad.
