## **Degree Completion Requirements**

The MATI program offers two options: a thesis option (eight courses, 24 credits) plus a thesis (6 credits), and a course option (10 courses, 30 credits). On average, the completion of all program requirements takes four semesters.

- Students must successfully complete a minimum of 30 credits in required courses and elective courses, inclusive of a research thesis (for the thesis option).
- Students must successfully complete the degree requirements within five years from the time of initial enrollment in the program.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 is required for graduation.
