## **Our Curriculum**

Based on the British early years foundation stage (EYFS) curriculum, our program helps children learn skills, acquire new knowledge and demonstrate their understanding through seven key areas. We first focus on the three prime areas most essential for your child's healthy development and future learning: communication and language, physical development, and personal, social and emotional development. As children grow, the prime areas will help them develop skills in four specific areas: literacy, mathematics, understanding the world, and expressive arts and design. Arabic lessons are also part of our program.

# **Children's Daily Life**

There is no such thing as a typical day in our center. We offer both teacher and child-led activities and we adapt our daily planned activities based on eachchild's responses, reactions and interests.

Your child will enjoy activities that cover all seven areas of the EYFS curriculum including, but are not limited to, numeracy and literacy activities, language development, story time, music, singing and dancing, sensory play, role play and imaginative play, arts and crafts, physical activities, exploration and discovery, learning about the world and environment, learning about social and skills, and the development of emotional intelligence. These activities are always age-appropriate and tailored to each unique child.

Not only that, but we also plan many fun events throughout the semester (e.g., UAE National Day celebrations, cultural week, storybook characters day, sports day, teddy bear picnic, and many more) which boost children's development.
