Our daily activities are a fun and educational way for children to learn in a non-teaching environment.

Each day, we offer a number of fun activities, including Arabic classes, computer programming (Matatalab), basic knowledge of how machines work (simple machines), sports, cooking, science experiments and a wide array of other activities. Participation in activities isn't compulsory, but we encourage all children to participate.

Our monthly schedule is pre-planned and shared with parents in advance.

Special Events

In collaboration with Dr. Feryal Qudourah of the AUS College of Arts and Sciences Performing Arts Program, the Epicenter is hosting weekly rehearsals of the AUS Children's Choir.

Every semester, another cycle of auditions is held so new children can participate in this free-of-charge program.
