Scholarships for New Students

President's Scholarship

Open to applicants who have completed their secondary education outside the UAE

- 100% of tuition and lab/technology fees
- Monthly stipend, housing, medical insurance
- Round-trip tickets and application fee waiver
- For first-time, first-year students starting in the fall semester

Fall 2026 application deadline: March 19, 2026

Chancellor's Scholarship

Open to applicants who have completed their secondary education in the UAE

- 100% of tuition and lab/technology fees
- Housing, medical insurance, application fee waiver
- For first-time, first-year students starting in the fall semester

Fall 2026 application deadline: March 19, 2026

Merit Scholarships

- Automatically offered at the time of processing the admission application to highly qualified new first-time students.

Sharakah School Scholarship

- 45% of tuition, lab/tech and on-campus housing
- Nomination of one exceptional AUS applicant from each Partner Sharakah Program School for the Sharakah School Scholarship, based on set guidelines

Scholarships for Continuing Students



Outstanding Academic Performance Scholarship

- 100% of tuition and lab/technology fees
- Completion of 60 credit hours by the end of any spring semester with cumulative GPA of 3.9 or above required
- Awarded for fall of third year



Dean's List Scholarship

- Up to 10% of tuition and lab/technology fees
- Minimum 3.50 semester GPA required



Chancellor's List Scholarship

- Up to 10% of tuition and lab/technology fees
- For students placed on the Chancellor's List at the end of the spring semester (on Dean's List for consecutive fall and spring semesters)



Active Student Scholarship

- Up to 25% tuition fee reduction
- Recognizes community service and extracurricular excellence



Athletic Scholarship

- Up to 25% tuition fee reduction
- Recognizes student athletes who excel at sports at AUS

Grants



Financial Grant

- 5%–50% of tuition and housing support
- Amount awarded depends on personal financial needs and academic qualifications
- Open to first-time, transfer and continuing students



Family Tuition Grant

- For families with more than one son/daughter simultaneously enrolled as undergraduate full-time students at AUS
- Awarded to each sibling after the first
