Learning Outcomes

Graduates of the PhD-MGT degree program will be prepared to:

- critique methods of research and academic inquiry in the field of management
- reconcile the results of research in the management field of study with extant theory
- identify, investigate and synthesize complex issues within the field by applying a range of analytical tools and theoretical models
- communicate research outcomes effectively to academic and practitioner audiences both orally and in writing
- produce scholarly work for peer-reviewed journals in management, strategy and related areas
- teach effectively and disseminate fundamental knowledge in the field of study and related areas in management

Degree Requirements

To qualify for graduation with PhD-MGT degree, students must successfully complete a minimum of **60 credit hours**, with a minimum cumulative **GPA of 3.00**:

12 credits core courses

18 credits elective courses

30 credits dissertation

They also must pass both the Qualifying and the Comprehensive Examinations.




