## SCHOLARSHIPS, BURSARIES AND GRANTS



International students (who are not US Citizens or Permanent Residents) are eligible for multiple scholarships, grants and bursaries, depending on their circumstances.

Our Admissions Scholarship Committee reviews each applicant individually for all scholarship and grant eligibility. We take an array of factors into consideration when making award determinations, such as personal, financial, academic, extracurricular, and other circumstances. We look at each student on a case by case basis, as we strive to award all deserving applicants. Students are only eligible to be evaluated or reviewed for bursaries and grants prior to registration. All eligible students will be evaluated for awards at the time of admission. Please note that all awards are for incoming first time students.
