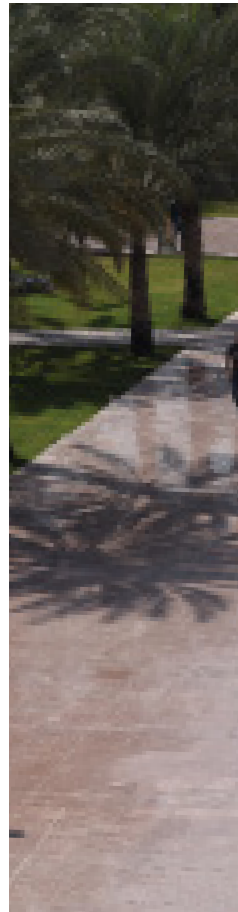

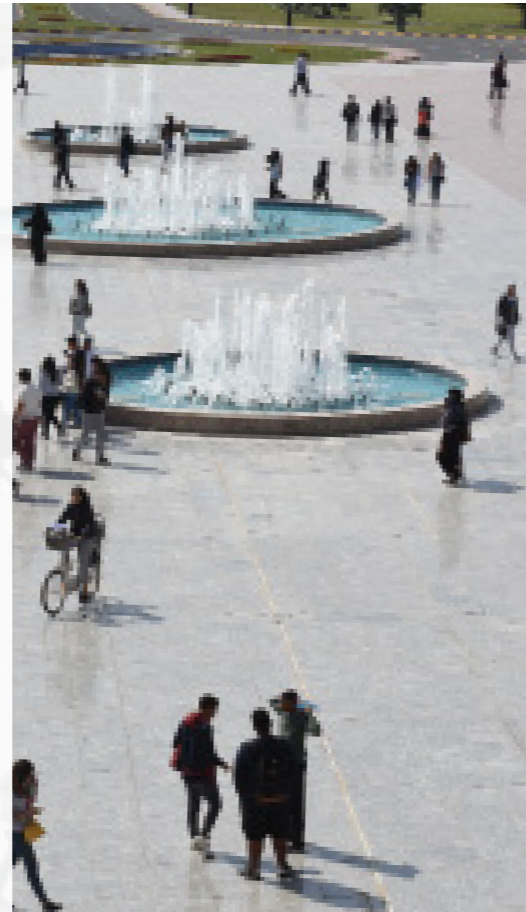


Prepare for an unparalleled student experience

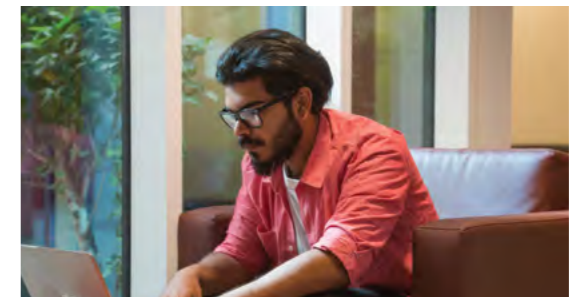

Types of Admission

Early

Applicants in their final year of secondary school are encouraged to apply for early admission by submitting official grade reports from at least the last two years (i.e., Grades 10 and 11) previous to the final year of secondary school.

Early applicants must complete the online application and provide:

- official grades from at least two previous years of secondary school study
- SAT Mathematics or EmSAT Mathematics (as applicable)
- TOEFL, IELTS (Academic) or EmSat-Achieve English (if applicable)

Important:

- Admission to CAAD and CEN is highly competitive. Students applying to programs offered by these colleges must apply early to reserve a seat.
- Applicants with the highest grades who have the required English proficiency testing scores (and SAT score as applicable) will be given priority consideration.
- Early admission is only offered to highly qualified students and not considered final until students submit the following documents before they may register for classes:
 - A recognized and officially certified secondary school certificate or equivalent showing successful completion of secondary education.
 - All other items requested in the letter of admission

Applications for Fall Semester 2020 open
October 1, 2019 and close on June 18, 2020

Regular

Applying after you have completed your final year of secondary school

Regular admission applicants must follow the regular application process and submit the following documents:

- a recognized and officially certified secondary school certificate or equivalent with the grades from the last three years of secondary schooling showing your grade average
- officially certified documentation of national secondary school final exam results (if taken)
- SAT Mathematics or EmSAT Mathematics (as applicable)
- TOEFL, IELTS (Academic) or EmSat-Achieve English (if applicable)

Applications for Fall Semester 2020 open on
June 18, 2020 and close July 16, 2020

Your admission to AUS will be on a competitive basis, depending on a variety of factors, including:

- secondary education certificate or school average
- SAT Mathematics or EmSAT Mathematics (as applicable)
- number of qualified applicants
- number of available seats
- TOEFL (iBT) score 80 and above, Institutional TOEFL (ITP) score 550 and above, IELTS (Academic) score 6.5 and above or EmSAT-Achieve English score of 1550 and above (as applicable)

Application Type

New

If you are applying to AUS as a fresh high school graduate, you must:

- meet the minimum admission requirements depending on the applicant's type of secondary education program and certificate.

See *Admissions Requirements for the full list of requirements for new applicants*, www.aus.edu/general-required-documents.

Transfer

If you are applying to transfer from another university to AUS, you must:

- be in good academic standing (i.e., not dismissed from the institution from which you are transferring).
 - be transferring from a recognized and accredited institution of higher learning offering learning experiences equivalent to those offered at AUS, and have successfully completed one or more semesters at that institution.
- Note: The College of Engineering and the School of Business Administration will only accept transfer credit for programs recognized by their respective accreditation bodies (ABET and AACSB) or from approved universities (SBA only).
- have met the minimum requirements for admission to AUS prior to your admission to the institution from which you are transferring.
 - submit official transcripts of high school and university/college records along with the syllabi and descriptions of the courses you wish to transfer.
 - have achieved a minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) as required by AUS for that type of institution.

Important:

- *Courses taken more than five years prior to matriculation as an AUS student are not transferrable.*
- *A maximum of 50 percent of the credits completed in residence at another institution can be considered for transfer.*
- *Decisions regarding the awarding of transfer credits are made solely by the appropriate division dean/department head at AUS.*

Returning

If you are returning to AUS after a period of absence, you must:

- be in good standing. Students who leave AUS for two or more consecutive semesters, inclusive of a semester of complete course withdrawal, must apply as returning applicants.

Readmission of returning applicants is subject to AUS academic rules and regulations.

Admission Requirements

As the university with the most international student community in the world (*Times Higher Education*), we understand that every applicant is different.

Depending on where you completed your secondary school studies, you'll need to meet specific admission requirements.

Admission to the university is competitive and the actual required minimum average for consideration and to guarantee a seat will depend on a number of factors, including your average secondary education scores, SAT scores (if applicable), the number of qualified applicants, the number of available seats and your English proficiency testing scores.

The minimum required average for accepting an application for consideration is the equivalent of 80 percent or more in the final year of secondary school (depending on the education system), or 80 percent or more in the best two out of the last three years. Higher averages may be applicable for certain colleges and/or majors. Other program-specific requirements may also apply.

Sample Secondary Certificates	Minimum Requirements
General Secondary School Certificate	Minimum average of 80% is required in the best two years of secondary education, or 80% in the final public examination
American-Style High School Diploma	Minimum of B or 80% average in the best two years of grades 10, 11 and 12 or final grade 12 alone
International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma	Obtain the IB Diploma with a minimum of 24 points and meet all other diploma requirements (Islamic Studies is not counted)
Indian Board(s)	Complete 12th Standard and typically obtain a minimum average as required by AUS in the best two years or in the final year

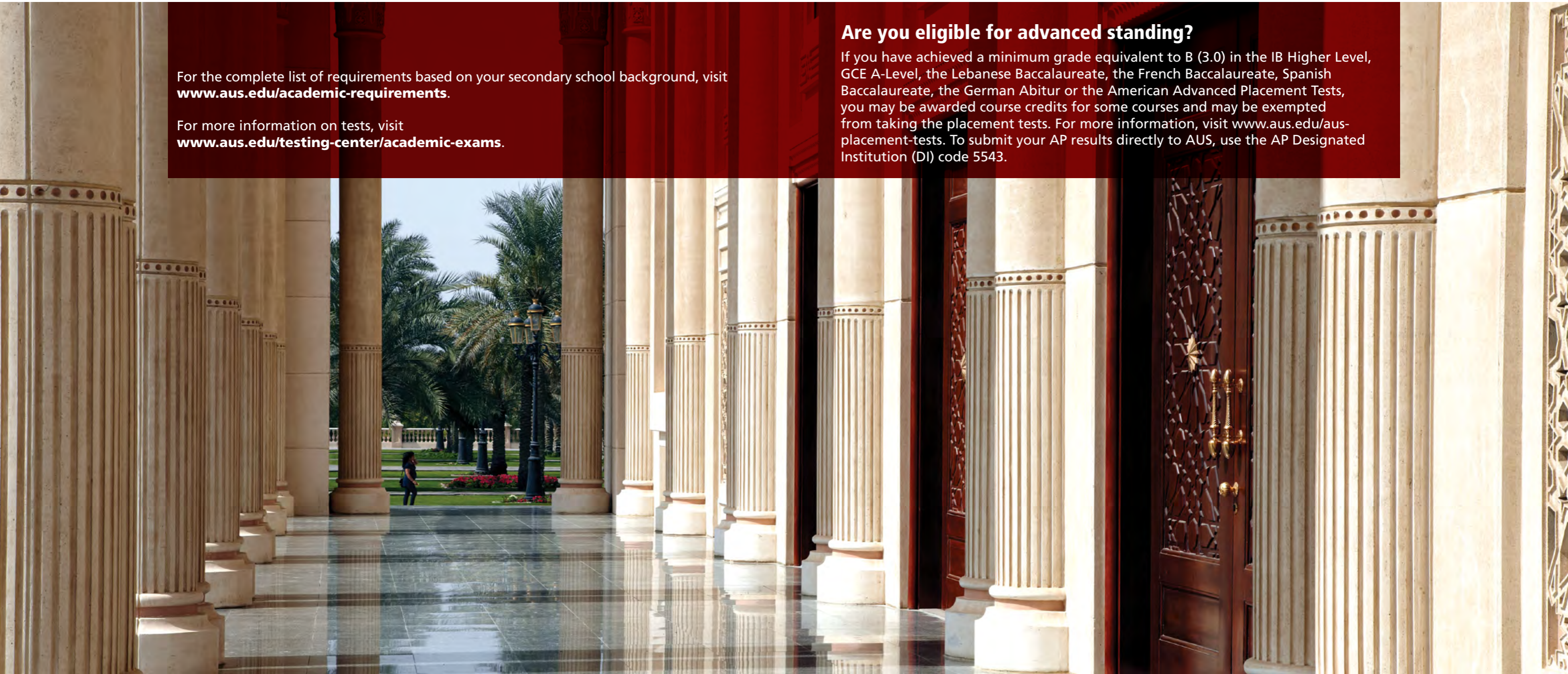

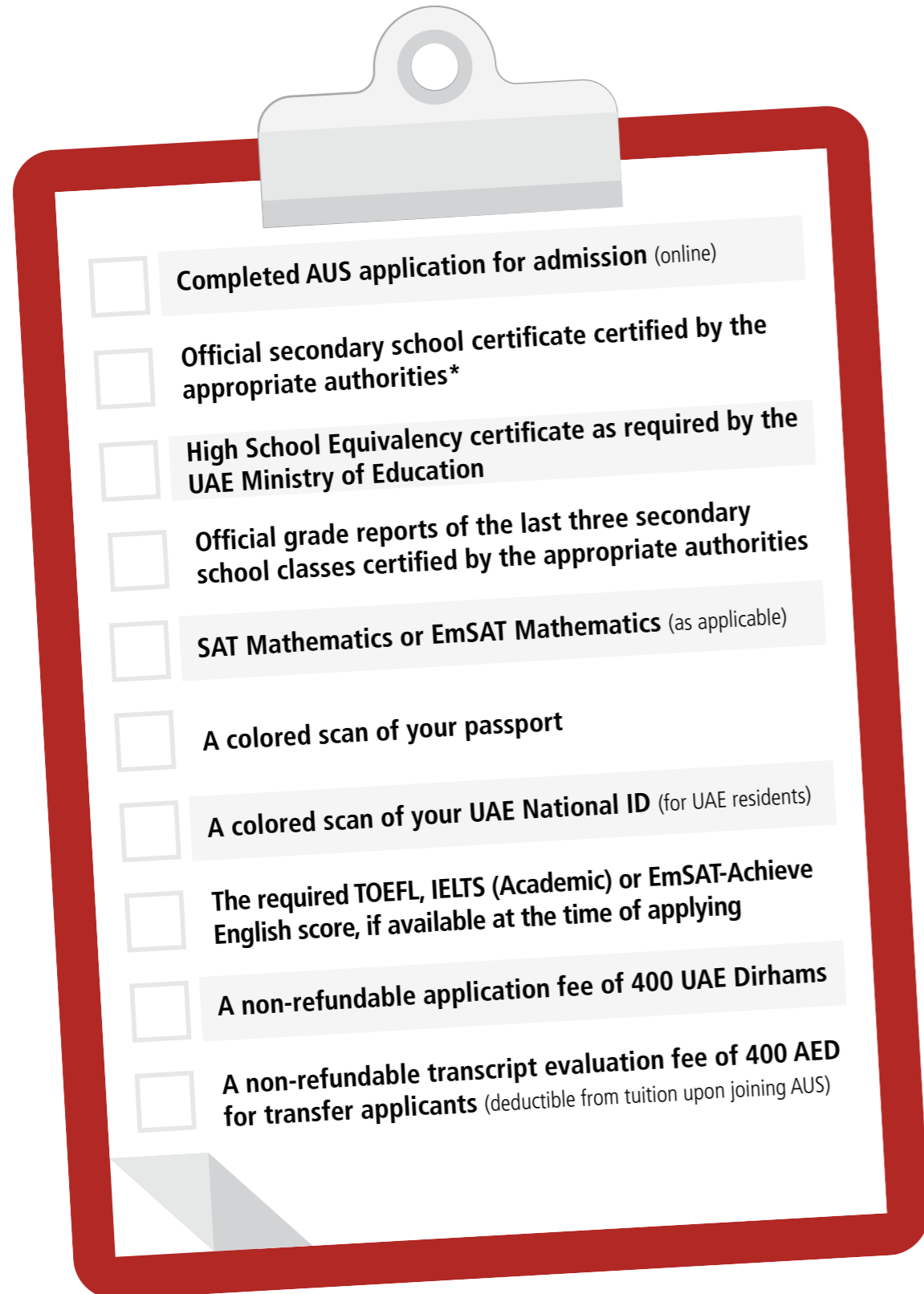
Are you eligible for advanced standing?

If you have achieved a minimum grade equivalent to B (3.0) in the IB Higher Level, GCE A-Level, the Lebanese Baccalaureate, the French Baccalaureate, Spanish Baccalaureate, the German Abitur or the American Advanced Placement Tests, you may be awarded course credits for some courses and may be exempted from taking the placement tests. Admission to AUS: The Next Steps

- 1. Confirm your admission:** You will be notified by AUS of your offer of admission in the mail, as well as online. You can check the status of your application and any possible missing documents by visiting www.aus.edu/application-status.
- 2. Pay your deposit to secure your place:** To guarantee a seat reservation you will be required to pay a 5,000 UAE Dirhams deposit, along with a 500 UAE Dirhams dorm room deposit if you choose to live on campus. Both deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable to others under any circumstances and must be paid before the published deadline.
- 3. Take the freshman placement tests:** All freshman students are required to take placement tests. Which tests you need to take depends on your selected major. See the table below:

4. Submit your official documents to complete your file: Check the website for the full list of official documents you may need to submit, including attested secondary school certificates, TOEFL, IELTS (Academic), EmSAT-Achieve English, SAT Mathematics, EmSAT Mathematics and High School Equivalency certificate as required by the UAE Ministry of Education.

5. Begin class registration: You will receive instructions on how to register for classes for your first semester of university studies at AUS. For the full list of courses available, see the *AUS Undergraduate Catalog* at www.aus.edu/aus-catalogs.

Financial Grants and Scholarships

Each year, AUS provides approximately AED 80 million in merit scholarships and need-based financial grants, benefiting approximately two-thirds of all enrolled AUS students.

These designated funds are available for highly qualified undergraduate students with limited financial resources. Admitted students who pay the seat reservation deposit before the deadline may apply for a financial grant, regardless of their race, color, gender, religion or national origin.

Once you have received your official Letter of Admission, you may request a grant/scholarship application form from the Office of Financial Grants.

Residential Halls

Just over 25 percent of AUS students live on campus. Residence on campus is optional and only available for full-time undergraduate students who have paid or arranged for the payment of their room, tuition and other university fees.
